Thursday, May 22nd

Field trip 1 – Tidal flat hike to Minsener Oog

(12 km; 5 h; 35 Euro, for students 15 Euro; max. number of participants 25; public transport to Schillig is available)

The hike to the uninhabited bird sanctuary island takes place on largely firm sandy tidal flats. Meeting and starting point is the beach of Schillig. Please find further information on www.wattwandern.de (we will send detailed information after registration).

Sunday, May 25th

Field trip 2 – Natural Wonders

(bus trip starting in Wilhelmshaven; all day; 45 Euro; max number of participants 20)

This field trip will cover several phenomena of our coast such as the Langwarder Groden: 'Natural Wonder of the Year 2024', Butjadingen beach ridge system, 'Sehestedter Außendeichsmoor', 'Geest' cliff at Dangast, bog peat development in Northwestern Germany.

Field trip 3 – Langeoog island

(10 km; all day; 40 Euro; max. number of participants 30)

The formation and geology of the island, its migration over time, storm surge washovers, coastal and dune defences, fresh water supply and flora will be discussed. The excursion will be on foot, the paths are paved, only shorter sections are on sandy stretches over the dunes to the beach.

Meeting and departure from the harbour of Bensorsiel at 9 am, return to Bensorsiel at 6 pm.

Parking is available at the harbour (approx. €6 per day). There is a connection to Esens railway station via the Tidebus after the ferry arrives in the evening. The train runs from Esens to Wilhelmshaven and Oldenburg. Long-distance connections should be checked in advance.
